Prayer Diary

Monday 29th August: Praise God for all those that have been involved in summer mission teams whether at home or away. As we begin to hear stories of their outreach, let us remember to continue to pray for those that have been touched by their work.

Tuesday 30th August: As the summer holidays draw to a close pray for those heading back to a new school term. Ask that the Lord will be with them as they meet fresh challenges.
