Monday 30th October 2017: Pray for the persecuted church. Across this world many Christian communities are suffering because of their faith. Pray that our God will encompass them with his love and protection. Also that Western Governments would offer to take in Christian families who have had to flee their homelands.

Tuesday 31st October 2017: May the grace of Christ, our Saviour, and the Father's boundless love, with the Holy Spirit's favour, rest upon us from above. Thus may we abide in union with each other and the Lord and possess, in sweet communion, joys which earth cannot afford. Amen.
