Prayer Diary

Monday 26th March 2018: Pray for the PCI workers involved in Thompson House (our supported Housing Scheme for men who have been in prison). Also pray for the residents, that they would come to know Christ as their Saviour.

Tuesday 27th March 2018: Pray for the chaplaincy service in our hospitals, and that the chaplains would know God's leading and wisdom each day.

Wednesday 28th March 2018: Continue to pray for the situation in Syria where many thousands have been killed and millions have had to flee their homes. The situation is both terrible and complex. Remember in prayer the innocent civilians caught up in this conflict.

Thursday 29th March 2018: Remember in prayer all our friends who have suffered bereavements. May the presence of the Lord be with them in their grief. May He comfort them in their loss and hold them in their sorrow.

Friday 30th March 2018: It's Good Friday. Let us remember today, the pain and suffering of the cross, and all that Jesus was willing to endure, so we could be set free. He paid the price, such a great sacrifice, to offer us the gift of eternal life.

Saturday 31st March 2018: *Isaiah 53:5. "But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed."* This prophecy foretold the crucifixion. Let us give thanks that we are redeemed. We have been given new life, an open door, through Jesus Christ.

Sunday 1st April 2018: Give thanks that God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. By Jesus wounds we are healed and sin and death have been conquered.
