Prayer Diary

When you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your father, who is unseen. Then your father who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

Matthew 6 v 6

Monday, 11th February: Give thanks for all God's goodness to us, for the freedom to worship yesterday and for the comfort and challenge of God's word. Pray for those who share the word with others through preaching or witnessing in practical ways.

Tuesday, 12th February: Remember Louise Hacking as she has completed her work with CUI. Pray for wisdom and guidance for Louise as she embarks on a new chapter in her life. Ask that she will see God's will clearly and know His presence each day.

Wednesday, 13th February: Ask God to bless the moderator of PCI as he undertakes many duties each week. May he know God's guidance in every task he faces. Pray for the moderator elect, Rev. William Henry, as he prepares to lead our church next year. May God grant him wisdom in all his decisions.

Thursday, 14th February: Pray for the Prime Minister, Theresa May, as she negotiates with the EU on behalf of the country. Ask for wisdom and patience for her in all the deliberations about Brexit and ask God to guide our nation in His way.
