Hi Everyone,

Well it has been just over a month now since I took up my  
responsibilities as the convenor of the Presbytery  
Commission appointed to look after things in Glengormley  
following David's retirement. I look forward to meeting

Behind the scenes it has been a busy month for session and  
committee. About 10 days ago they met with the  
Presbytery Commission and the 'paperwork' was more or  
less completed to enable congregational representatives  
to meet with the Linkage Commission in September. That  
commission is the central Presbyterian body that grants  
congregations leave – or permission – to call ministers. Once  
that permission is granted to Glengormley, the search for a  
new minister can really begin. So far the progress has been  
good and we are as far on as we can expect to be at this  
stage.
