GPC PRAYER: Join us on **Sunday mornings** between **10:00 and 10:20am** (in the Burney Room). Whether you can come along for the whole time or drop in and pray for part of the time, you will be very welcome as we seek God 'for such a time as this'.

- *How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!
