Prayer

*"Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth.
Worship the Lord with gladness."*

Psalm 100:1-2.

Ask that God would help you to worship him with exuberance, giving heart, soul, mind and strength to your participation in praise, prayer and listening to the preaching of his Word.
